Information and Rules for Essay Contest Sponsored by the Western Pennsylvania Firemen's Association

- 1. Essays must be submitted on 8 1/2 by 11 inch white paper, one sided only, and not over 30 written lines on each sheet. Essays may be hand written, typed, or computer generated.
- 2. Essays should not be more than five pages long.
- 3. Essays will be judged for neatness, originality, composition and Fire Prevention ideas.
- 4. Each member Fire Company or Association whose current dues are paid is eligible to send up to three essays from each grade level to compete for prizes.
